

WORK PLACEMENT IN A SUMMER LEISURE CENTRE - PLL

The PLL (Patronage Laïque de Lorient) is a popular education association dedicated to offering children and young people a wide range of educational leisure activities in their free time, accessible to all.

The PLL leisure centres welcome children aged 3-6 / 6-11 / 11-15 (including children with disabilities) during the summer holidays in July and August.

Dates to be confirmed :

From 8 July to 2 August

From 5 August to 30 August.

The 4 nursery and elementary leisure centres are open from 7.30am to 7pm, and the centre for teenagers is open from 8.30am to 5.30pm.

Trainees will be accompanied on a daily basis by qualified activity leaders, under the responsibility of the director of the Patronage Laïque de Lorient leisure centre.

They will be required to :

- Take part in setting up fun activities with the activities team for children aged 3-6 / 6-11 or 11-15.
- Listen to the children
- Be aware of their educational role with children (behaviour and language adapted to children, etc...)
- Help children to learn to live together (tidy up games, respect others, help each other, etc...)
- Communicate with the team to play an active part in the day's activities
- Demonstrate autonomy and motivation
- Respect the work placement timetable or inform the management team in the event of absence.

This training is unpaid. Accommodation in a young workers' hostel is paid for by the City of Lorient.
